Salem, Mass is an old fishing and farming settlement originally named Naumkeag, meaning "fishing place," by the Native Americans who lived there. In 1692, Salem residents were overcome by a hysteria which caused them to seek out and persecute "witches" they believed were working for the Devil. This later came to be known as the Salem Witch Trials.
